
Kurt is creative and handy! His hobbies include classic car repair, making rustic log furniture, ATVing and helping make my home improvement ideas a reality!

Andrew is a sophomore this year and just got his driving license!


He stays active in football and works nearby on a dairy farm.


Time to relax


Ralph and Eleanor






We're Better Together


Our Home and Neighborhood
